RESOLVE in favor of Building a Bridge across the Fish river
in the town of Fort Kent, Aroostook county.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars be hereby
2 appropriated in aid of building a bridge across the Fish river
3 in the town of Fort Kent, Aroostook county, providing, how-
4 ever, that said town of Fort Kent appropriate twelve hun-
5 dred dollars towards the same and the whole sum be ex-
6 pended under the direction of the county commissioners of
7 Aroostook county.
