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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

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AN ACT establishing the Salaries of the County Commissioners and the salary of the County Treasurer for the county of York.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after the first day of January in the 2 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-3 nine. The salary of each of the county commissioners of 4 the county of York shall be six hundred dollars annually, 5 payable in quarterly payments, on the last days of March, 6 June, September and December, which shall be in full for 7 all services, expenses and travel.

Sect. 2. From and after the first day of January in the  
2 year of our Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, the  
3 salary of the county treasurer of the county of York shall be  
4 six hundred dollars annually, payable quarterly on the last  
5 days of March, June, September and December, which shall  
6 be in full for all services, expenses and travel.

Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the  
2 above act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
