STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT establishing the Salaries of the County Commissioners and the salary of the County Treasurer for the county of York.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. From and after the first day of January in the

- 2 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
- 3 nine. The salary of each of the county commissioners of
- 4 the county of York shall be six hundred dollars annually,
- 5 payable in quarterly payments, on the last days of March,
- 6 June, September and December, which shall be in full for
- 7 all services, expenses and travel.

- Sect. 2. From and after the first day of January in the 2 year of our Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, the 3 salary of the county treasurer of the county of York shall be 4 six hundred dollars annually, payable quarterly on the last 5 days of March, June, September and December, which shall 6 be in full for all services, expenses and travel.
- Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the 2 above act are hereby repealed.
 - Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
