RESOLVE respecting the Cemetery Lot of the late Governor William King.

Resolved, That the treasurer of the city of Bath be and is 2 hereby authorized to pay five hundred dollars of the appropria-3 tion made in 1897 and paid to said city for the perpetual care 4 of the cemetery lot of the late Governor William King, to the 5 cemetery and park board of said city and said board is hereby 6 authorized to expend the same in repairing and remodeling the 7 monument thereon and grading the same, and that the remain-8 der of said appropriation be held in trust by said city, the 9 income thereof at the rate of four per cent yearly to be paid to 10 said board and by them expended for the perpetual care of said 11 lot.
