IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend the Charter of the Bangor Boom Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter 352 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1897 is hereby amended by striking out in the
3 sixth line the word "ten" and inserting in the place thereof the
4 word 'six,' so that said section as amended shall read as
5 follows:

'Sect. 1. The charter of the Bangor Boom Company, with all
7 the rights and privileges and all the responsibilities attaching
8 to said company by virtue of the several acts creating, extend-
9 ing and relating thereto, shall continue and remain in force for
10 twenty years from March, eighteen hundred and ninety-eight,

11 provided, however, that said company shall receive as toll six
12 cents for each thousand feet in lieu of twenty cents as provided
13 in chapter seventy-five of the Special Laws of the year eighteen
14 hundred and eighty-one, in the case therein provided of the
15 work of driving and rafting being done by one contractor, as
16 now done.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
