## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

---

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter one hundred and fifteen  
of the Revised Statutes, relating to Salaries of Public Officers.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section one of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the Revised  
2 Statutes, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended, by insert-  
3 ing before the "guards" in the twenty-first paragraph, relating  
4 to the salaries of prison officials the words, 'officer of the  
5 guard six hundred dollars,' so that said paragraph as amended  
6 shall read as follows :

'Warden of the state prison, eighteen hundred dollars, with  
8 the use, without charge, of such part of the keeper's house and  
9 buildings of the state, appurtenant to the prison and yard, as

10 the governor and council may direct, and fuel for his own use ;  
11 which shall be in full for all services, including duty of receiv-  
12 ing and paying out money for all purposes ; deputy warden,  
13 one thousand dollars ; clerk, one thousand dollars, officer of the  
14 guard six hundred dollars, guards five hundred dollars each ;  
15 physician, two hundred and fifty dollars ; chaplain, two hun-  
16 dred and fifty dollars ; gate keeper, five hundred dollars ;  
17 teacher, three hundred dollars.'
