STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to legalize the incorporation, the records and the doings of the Hartland Hall Association of Hartland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The records of the meetings of the Hartland Hall
- 2 Association of the town of Hartland wherein and whereby said
- 3 association was incorporated as the Hartland Hall Association
- 4 and all its doings under and since its incorporation, are hereby
- 5 legalized.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
