STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize Benjamin Desjardin to maintain a wharf
into the tide waters of New Meadow river, in the town of
Brunswick, County of Cumberland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Benjamin Desjardin and his assigns is hereby
2 authorized to maintain a wharf from his shore front on the
3 west side of New Meadows river, otherwise called Stevens
4 river, into the tide waters of said New Meadows river, in the
5 town of Brunswick, county of Cumberland, to extend to the
6 channel.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
