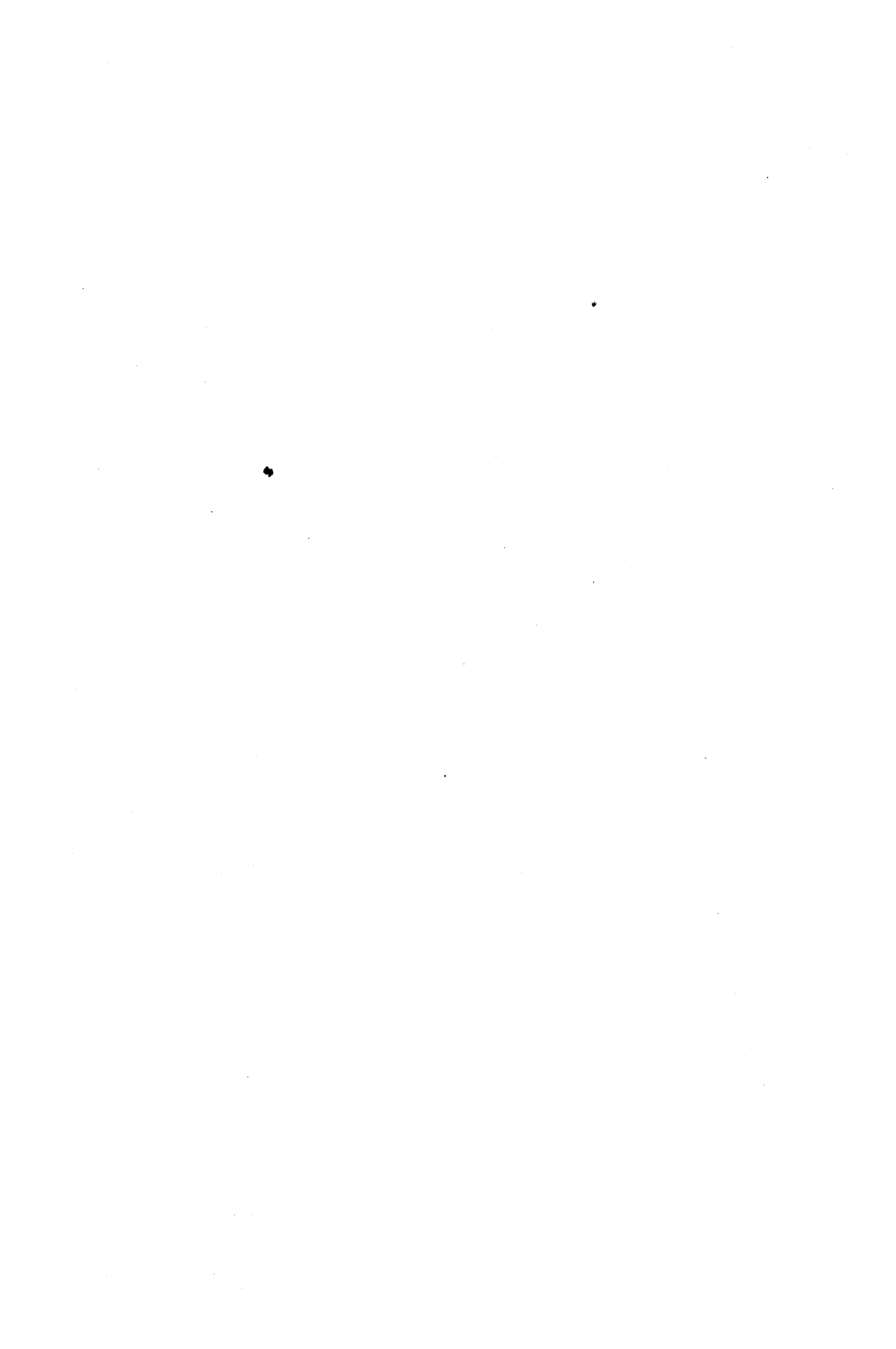
AN ACT to repeal chapter 461 of the Private and Special Laws of 1885, and chapter 377 of the Private and Special Laws of 1897, and acts additional thereto and amendatory thereof, relating to School District No. 5 in the Town of Kennebunk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter four hundred and sixty-one of the
2 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-
3 five entitled "An Act granting additional powers to the
4 Inhabitants of School District No. 5, in the town of Ken-
5 nebunk;" and also chapter three hundred and seventy-seven
6 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
7 ninety-seven entitled "An Act to repeal so much of chapter
8 461 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred
9 and eighty-five, entitled 'An Act granting additional powers

10 to the inhabitants of school district number five, in the town
11 of Kennebunk' and acts additional thereto and amendatory
12 thereof, as relates to the maintenance of schools and school-
13 houses," and all acts additional thereto and amendatory
14 thereof are each and all hereby repealed: and School Dis-
15 trict No. 5, in the town of Kennebunk is hereby abolished:
16 But the same shall remain in force and existence so far as is
17 necessary for the disposition of the funds and property of
18 said district which may be done by a vote at a regular meet-
19 ing thereof, called by the clerk for said purposes, by the
20 usual notice; as well as for the collection of all dues and
21 taxes and for all purposes necessary in closing up the affairs
22 of the district.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
