STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit the killing of deer on the Isle Au Haute
in Hancock County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch, or kill,
2 in any manner, any deer on the island of Isle Au Haute, in the
3 County of Hancock, for a period of six years from October
4 first, eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.
