STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit the killing of deer on the Isle Au Haute in Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch, or kill,

- 2 in any manner, any deer on the island of Isle Au Haute, in the
- 3 County of Hancock, for a period of six years from October
- 4 first, eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.
