STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUK LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to enable the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game to increase the State Museum consisting of mounted specimens and pictures of the birds, wild animals, and fishes native to the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The commissioners of inland fisheries and game are hereby 2 authorized to expend not exceeding three hundred dollars yearly 3 for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine and 4 not exceeding three hundred dollars for the year nineteen hun-5 dred for the purpose of adding to the state museum mounted 6 specimens and pictures of the wild animals, birds, and fishes 7 native to the state of Maine, the money for which shall be taken 8 from the appropriation for inland fisheries and game, for these 9 years. . . ,
