IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to establish the Salary of the Judge of Probate for the County of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

On and after January one, eighteen hundred and ninety-2 nine, the salary of the judge of probate within and for the

- 3 county of Hancock shall be one thousand dollars per annum
- 4 instead of the sum now fixed by law.
