STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter and rights of the Sanford Mills.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. The Sanford Mills, a corporation existing under
2 the general laws of the State of Maine, is hereby authorized
3 and empowered to carry on the following business, in addition
4 to those named in its certificate of organization.

Sect. 2. To engage in the manufacture of mohair and other
2 plushes, carriage robes, blankets and textile goods.

Sect. 3. To purchase, or otherwise acquire real estate, lum-
2 ber or interest therein that may be beneficial to the company.

3 To hold, develop, improve, sell, or otherwise use or dispose of
4 any lands or property belonging to the company, or in which
5 the company is interested.

Sect. 4. To own and operate saw mills, and to manufacture
2 wood and lumber.

Sect. 5. To manufacture, mold and build machinery of all
2 kinds of whatever materials.

Sect. 6. To charter, hire, use, and lease freight vessels of
2 any description to carry on the business of freight upon the
3 high seas, or from any port or ports in Maine to any other do-
4 mestic port or ports.

Sect. 7. To carry on any mercantile or other business inci-
2 dental to the ownership, operation or development of its prop-
3 erty or any that it may acquire.

Sect. 8. To acquire, hold and dispose of shares of capital
2 stock and mortgage bonds of any and all corporations doing
3 business on the Monson river, in the county of York, and of
4 any and all other corporations doing a similar business, as per
5 section second of this act.
