
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to The Young Men's Christian Association of Portland, Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The Young Men's Christian Association of the
- 2 city of Portland, Maine, a corporation organized under the laws
- 3 of this State and located at said Portland in county of Cumber-
- 4 land, which organization is hereby ratified, confirmed and de-
- 5 clared to be legal and valid, is authorized and empowered for
- 6 the purpose of its organization to receive, take and hold by deed,
- 7 devise, bequest or otherwise, property, personal and real, to the
- 8 amount of three hundred thousand dollars.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
