STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Settling Lots in Drew Plantation.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to sell and
2 convey to actual settlers thereon certain lots in Drew Plantation,
3 which constitute the school lot of said plantation, at the sum of
4 seventy-five cents per acre; provided, that in making the sales
5 of said lots the legal and equitable rights of persons claiming
6 under said settlers shall be considered and preserved; and pro-
7 vided also, that the proceeds of any sales made shall be added
8 to the school fund of said plantation.
