STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter two hundred and one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-four, relating to Bridgton Center Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred and one of the Private and 2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-four is hereby 3 amended, so that the same shall read as follows :

‘Sect. 1. The territory which lies westerly of Long pond in 5 the town of Bridgton, county of Cumberland, and embraced 6 within the following described lines, namely : Beginning on the 7 westerly shore of said Long pond, at a point thereon where the 8 southerly range line of the fourteenth range of lots of said town 9 intersects said shore ; thence westerly on said range line, being 10 northerly line of land of Mary G. Perley, about forty-four rods

11 to the southwesterly corner of the Eli Plummer estate ; thence
12 north one degree west, eighty-nine rods by the westerly line of
13 said Plummer estate, to the northwesterly corner thereof ; thence
14 south seventy degrees west, one hundred twelve rods, running
15 across the Delano road, to a point on the east end line of lot
16 numbered eight, in said fourteenth range, being the north-
17 westerly corner of land of Hanson Fields and the southwesterly
18 corner of the homestead lot of Martha M. Stedman ; thence
19 north twenty degrees west, on the east end line of said lot num-
20 bered eight in said fourteenth range, twenty-four and one-fifth
21 rods, to the northeasterly corner of said lot ; thence north thirty-
22 two and one-half degrees west, on the east end line of lot num-
23 bered eight in the thirteenth range of said town's lots to the
24 division corner thereon of land of Chester E. Douglass and
25 Lucinda C. Gray ; thence south sixty-seven and one-fourth
26 degrees west, running a distance of about one hundred rods by
27 the north line of said Chester E. Douglass' land, to the center
28 of the North Bridgton road leading over Hoyt's Hill ; thence
29 south about seventy degrees west, by the northerly line of land
30 of Joshua F. Bennett, eighty-seven rods to the southwest corner
31 of land of Augustus E. Douglass ; thence north nine and one-
32 half degrees west, by the westerly land of said Douglass' land,
33 twenty-seven rods to the southeast corner of lot numbered
34 seven in the twelfth range of said town's lots ; thence northerly,
35 to wit, north twenty-three and one-half degrees west, and by the
36 east end line of said lot seven in said twelfth range, one hundred
37 twenty-eight rods to the northeasterly corner of said lot ; thence
38 south seventy-two degrees west, and on the north range line of
39 said lot seven in the twelfth range, and running on the north-
40 erly side of George W. Emery's homestead lot and across the
41 Ridge road nearly in front of said Emery's residence, a distance
42 of fifty-two rods, to the easterly shore of Highland lake ; thence
43 crossing said Highland lake on said range line, to a point where

44 said line intersects the westerly shore-line of said lake, south
45 of Little island; thence northerly by said Highland lake's west-
46 erly shore, to the division corner thereon of land of William H.
47 Larrabee and A. Kimball Carsley; thence south thirty-four
48 and one-half degrees west by the northerly line of land of said
49 Larrabee, thirty-six rods to the center of North High street;
50 thence south sixty-nine degrees west, on the northerly line of
51 said Larrabee's land, about one hundred sixty rods to a point
52 on the west end line of lot numbered six in the eleventh range
53 of said town's lots: thence southerly on the west end line of
54 said lot six, to the southwesterly corner of said lot: thence
55 southerly by the west end lines of lot numbered six in the
56 twelfth range, and lot numbered six in the thirteenth range, to
57 the southwesterly corner of said lot numbered six in said thir-
58 teenth range; thence easterly on the southerly range line of
59 said lot numbered six in said thirteenth range, seventy-eight
60 rods to land of Walter S. Hazen: thence south eighteen degrees
61 east, eighteen rods, by said Hazen's westerly line, to the south-
62 westerly corner of said Hazen's land: thence north seventy-two
63 degrees east, by the southerly line of said Hazen's land, eighty-
64 three rods to the center of High street: thence due south, down
65 the center of said High street, eighteen and four-fifths rods to
66 a point therein: thence north eighty-five degrees east, to the
67 easterly line of said High street, continuing on same course on
68 the northerly side line of land of Eben A. Cross, twenty-nine
69 rods to a jog in the line-wall of a pasture lane: thence due
70 north, by said jog, one rod: thence north seventy-eight degrees
71 east, forty rods: thence north seventy degrees east, fifty-eight
72 rods, to a white pine tree standing on a point on the westerly
73 bank of Willett brook: thence on same course, about eighteen
74 rods, across said Willett brook, to a post on the easterly bank
75 thereof, and near the roadbed of the Bridgton and Saco River
76 Railroad: thence south sixteen degrees east, and along the

77 roadbed of said railroad, eighty-nine and one-fifth rods, to a
78 point mid-way between the rails of said railroad: thence north
79 seventy-two and one-fourth degrees east, nineteen and one-fifth
80 rods, to a point on the easterly side line of Portland street, and
81 at its intersection with the center line of the Martin road:
82 thence on same course up said Martin road, forty-seven and
83 two-fifths rods, to a point in the center thereof: thence north
84 seventy-nine and one-fourth degrees east, up the center of said
85 road, eighteen rods and twenty-two links to a point: thence
86 north seventy-one and one-half degrees east, up the center of
87 said road, twenty and three-fifths rods to a point; thence
88 north seventy-nine and three-fourths degrees east, thirty rods
89 to the end of the wall on the north side of the gate-way leading
90 out of the easterly side of the door-yard at the Martin home-
91^{stead}, into the pasture of William H. Larrabee: thence north
92 seventy-three and one-fourth degrees east, thirty-six and one-
93 half rods, to corner of land of said William H. Larrabee and
94 the Forest Mills Company: thence north seventy-eight degrees
95 east, on the division line of lands of said Larrabee and said
96 Forest Mills Company, twenty-four rods to their common
97 corner in the mill-pond of said company, just westerly of the
98 Kansas road: thence north fifty-six degrees east, crossing
99 said road and running a distance of nine and three-fifths rods,
100 to the center of the southwesterly outlet or waste-way of said
101 mill-pond: thence down said outlet, south about sixty-six
102 degrees east, about eighteen rods to the center of Stevens
103 brook, below the lower mill of said Forest Mills Company:
104 thence easterly, and down the thread of said Stevens brook,
105 to a point therein opposite an old spotted maple tree standing
106 in a bend on said brook's southerly bank, said maple being
107 the westerly corner of the Levi Butters homestead: thence
108 southerly to said spotted maple tree and from thence south
109 seventy-six degrees east, on the southerly line of said Butters

110 homestead, thirty-two rods, crossing the Harte tannery road,
111 to the southeasterly corner of said Butters' homestead ; the same
112 being a stake and stones on the easterly side and near to said
113 Harte tannery road : thence north twenty-four and one-half de-
114 grees east, seven and one-fifth rods, to a stone corner on the east-
115 erly side of said road, between land of said William H. Larrabee
116 and the Bridgton and Harrison Electric Company : thence east-
117 erly, south about eighty-one and one-half degrees east, by the
118 northerly line of said Larrabee's land, eighty-one rods to said
119 Long pond, together with the inhabitants thereon, be and the
120 same hereby is created a body politic and corporate, by the
121 name of the Bridgton Center Village Corporation.'
