STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to create a Lien upon Hay for the Cutting and Pressing Thereof.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Whoever labors in cutting or harvesting hay
- 2 has a lien on all the hay cut or harvested by him and his
- 3 co-laborers for the amount due for his personal services and
- 4 the services performed by his team, which takes precedence
- 5 of all other claims except liens reserved to the State, con-
- 6 tinues for thirty days after the last of such services are per-
- 7 formed and may be enforced by attachment.
- Sect. 2. Whoever presses hay has a lien on all the hay so 2 pressed for the amount due for such pressing which takes

- 3 precedence of all other claims except liens reserved to the
- 4 State and the lien specified in the first section of this act, con-
- 5 tinues for thirty days after said pressing is completed, and
- 6 may be enforced by attachment.
