STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of State Normal Schools.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of fifteen hundred dollars for the year eighteen hundred and
3 ninety-nine, and the like sum of fifteen hundred dollars for
4 the year nineteen hundred, for repairs and supplies for the
5 Farmington, Gorham and Castine State Normal Schools, the
6 same to be expended under the direction of the trustees of
7 State normal schools.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In each of these schools there is need of repairs and supplies every term, such as blackboards, chairs, painting, text books, reference books, plastering, ceilings, water closets, sewerage, grading, etc., requiring about five hundred dollars a year for each school.
