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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

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AN ACT to fix the Salary of the Sheriff of the County of  
Waldo.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The sheriff of the county of Waldo from and  
2 after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred  
3 and ninety-nine, shall receive an annual salary of four hun-  
4 dred dollars from the county treasury instead of the com-  
5 pensation provided in section twenty-three of chapter eighty  
6 of the Revised Statutes and it is further provided that the  
7 sheriff of said county shall not receive from any of his  
8 deputies any of the fees earned by said deputies or any per-  
9 centage earned thereon after said date.

Provided, however, that said sheriff on the first day of  
11 January annually shall state a true account of the amount  
12 accruing to him for board of prisoners under his care during  
13 the preceding year and make a true return thereof under  
14 oath to the treasurer of said county and when the sum so  
15 accruing to him in any year for such board of prisoners  
16 shall exceed the sum of twelve hundred dollars then he shall  
17 not receive any part of said salary for such year.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
