RESOLVE to reimburse Daniel S. Chadbourne for Repairs on
Breakwater at Mattawamkeag Bridge.

Resolved, That the sum of eighteen and twenty-two-hun-
2 dredths dollars (\$18 22-100) be and is hereby appropriated
3 to reimburse Daniel S. Chadbourne of Mattawamkeag for
4 the sum expended by him more than the appropriation for
5 repairs on breakwater at Mattawamkeag bridge.

The above statement shows the account as far as we have paid. The above logs were taken from the drive as they run down to Mattawamkeag and we found them marked as above. In our settlement with D. S. Chadbourne his bill amounting to \$252.46 was reduced by turning over to him what lumber remained from the job, \$22.62, leaving the net amount of his bill, \$229.84, of which we paid him as above, \$211.62, leaving a balance due him, \$18.22.
