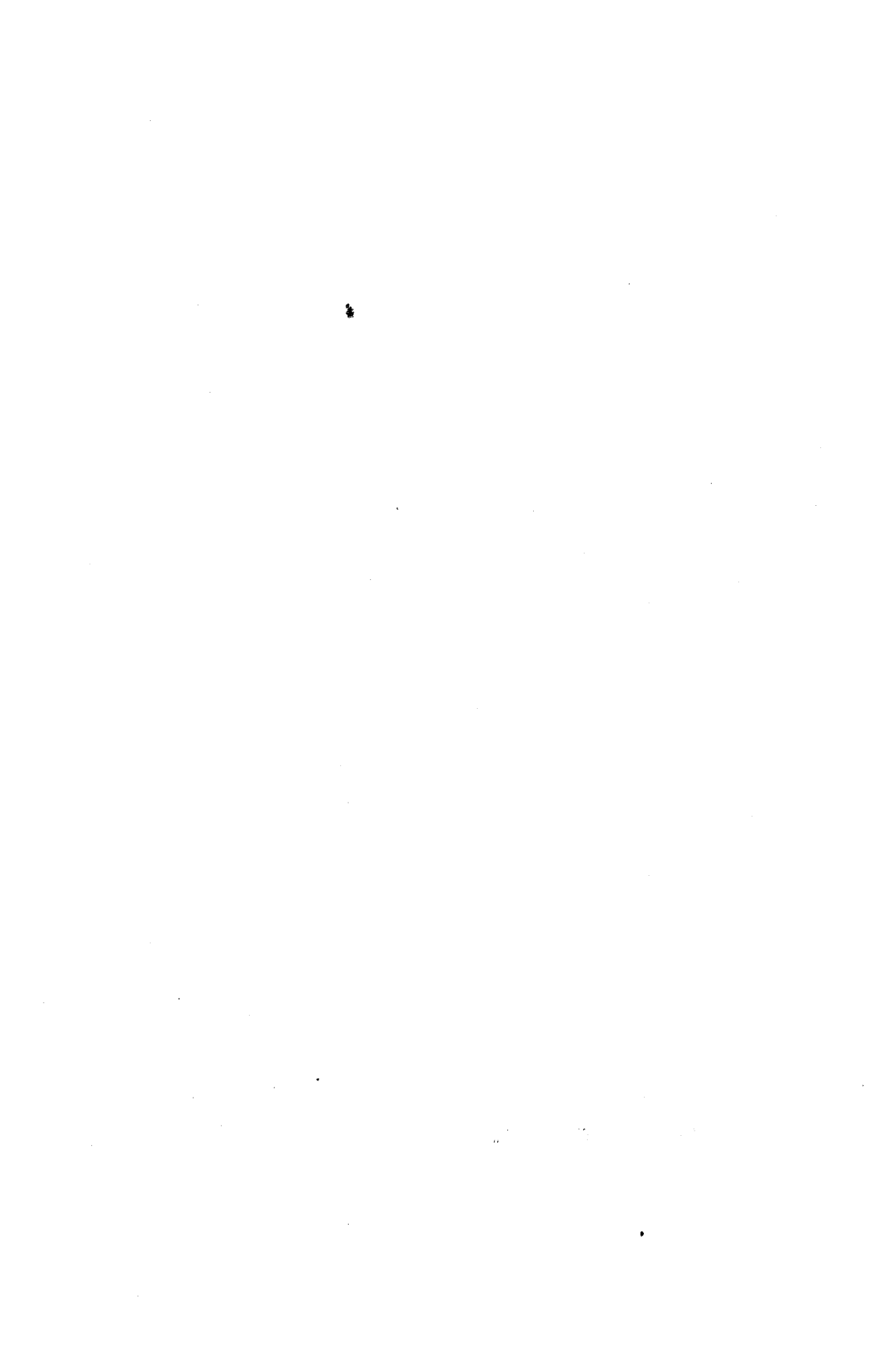

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing a change in the location of a right of way
to State Lands in Augusta.

Resolved, That the governor and council be authorized to
2 cause a release to be executed to William H. Gannett, his heirs
3 or assigns, of a certain right of way named in a deed from
4 Charles H. Mulliken to the State of Maine dated June 11, 1889,
5 and recorded in Kennebec registry of deeds' book 375 pages
6 570 and 571, said release to be executed by the governor, or
7 by the chairman of the Committee on Military Affairs of the
8 executive council, in behalf of the state. Said release to be
9 executed on the condition that the said William H. Gannett
10 convey to the state a right of way to the lands conveyed by the
11 said deed, from Western avenue in Augusta, to the acceptance
12 of the governor and council.
