

## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to reimburse F. I. Campbell, treasurer of the town of Cherryfield, for money paid to State Pensioners.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred forty-four dollars be 2 and hereby is appropriated to be paid to F. I. Campbell, treas-3 urer of the town of Cherryfield for the year eighteen hundred 4 ninety-four, to reimburse him for money expended by him and 5 paid to the state pensioners of said town for said year.

The above pensioners and amounts are the same as paid in the preceding year as per certificates on file in the state pension office, but pension certificates were not renewed for said year on account of neglect of town officers to apply for same. No other money was paid to state pensioners in the town of Cherryfield for the year eighteen hundred ninety-four as may be shown by the state pension agent's accounts.
