STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter six of the Revised Statutes, relating to Poll Taxes, by adding to said section the words 'which said Poll Tax shall not exceed Three Dollars and shall not be less than One Dollar.'

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter six of the Revised Statutes is hereby
2 amended by adding to said section the words 'which said
3 poll tax shall not exceed three dollars and shall not be less
4 than one dollar,' so that said section as amended, shall read
5 as follows:

'Section 1. A poll tax shall be assessed upon every male
7 inhabitant of the State above the age of twenty-one years,

8 whether a citizen of the United States or an alien, in the
9 manner provided by law, unless he is exempted therefrom
10 by this chapter, which said poll tax shall not exceed three
11 dollars and shall not be less than one dollar.'
