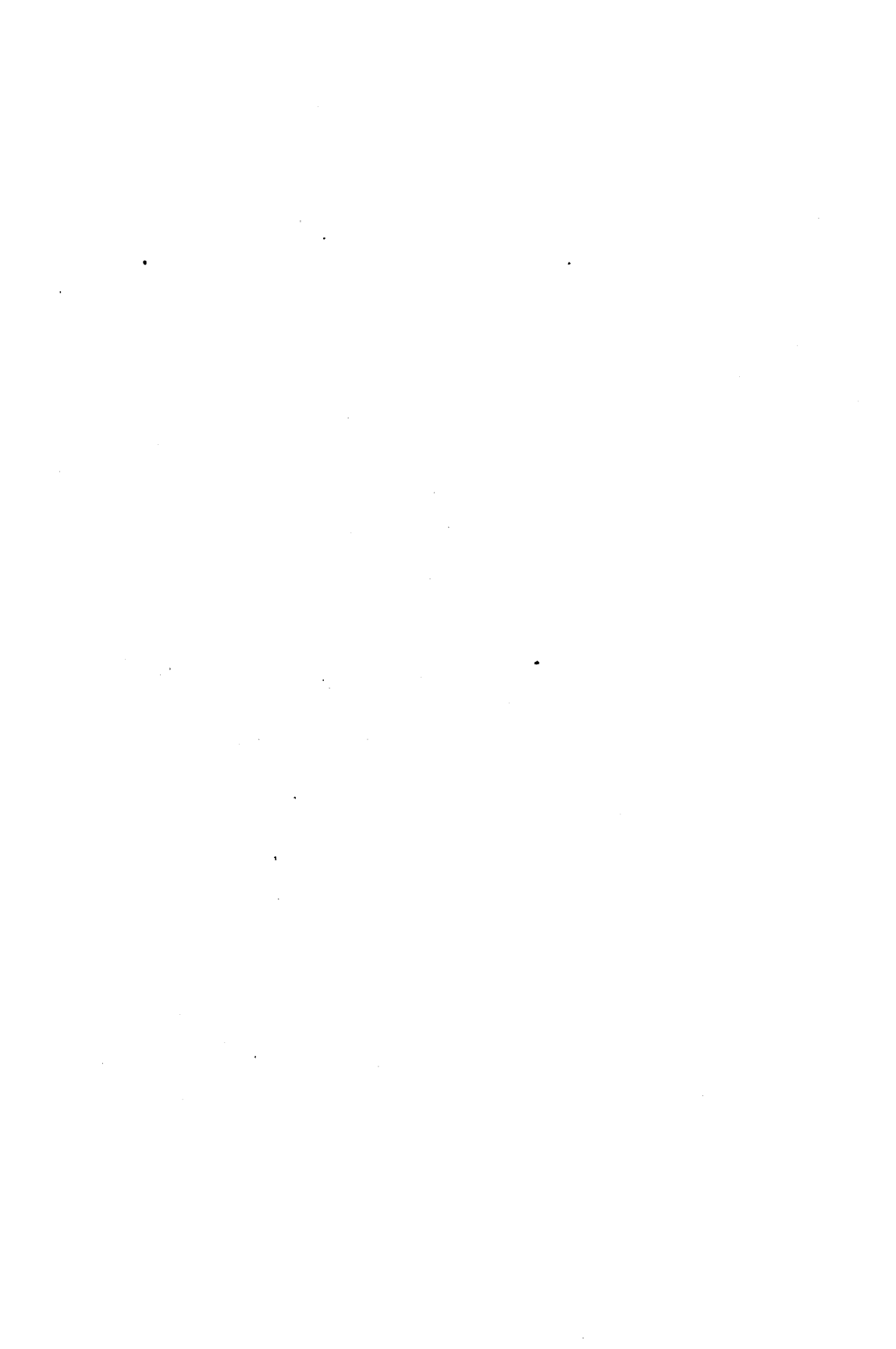
AN ACT to amend section eleven, chapter seventy-eight, of the Revised Statutes, relating to the duties of County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 11, chapter 78, of the Revised Statutes, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the words, "court-houses" in the
3 second line of said section, the following words: 'with a
4 suitable room in each for the county law library,' so that said
5 section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 11. They shall, in the shire town of their county, pro-
7 vide and keep in repair, court-houses, with a suitable room in
8 each for the county law library; jails, with apartments for

9 debtors separate from criminals; and fire-proof buildings of
10 brick or stone for the safe keeping of records and papers
11 belonging to the offices of register of deeds and of probate, and
12 of the clerk of the courts, with separate fire-proof rooms, and
13 suitable alcoves, cases or boxes for each office, and also any
14 other necessary buildings.'
