STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 450 of the Private and Special Laws
of 1893, Incorporating the City of Eastport.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. To amend section twenty-nine by striking out the
2 words "one from each ward," so that it shall read :

3 "There shall be elected a board of four assessors on the third
4 Monday in March annually, or as soon as may be thereafter,
5 regardless of ward lines, by the city council by a majority of
6 all its members, by roll call. The compensation of the assess-
7 ors shall be fixed by city council and shall not be increased or
8 diminished during the municipal year for which they are elected.
9 The assessors shall hold office until the third Monday in March
10 following their election and until their successors are chosen

11 and qualified. All taxes shall be assessed, apportioned and
12 collected in the same manner prescribed by the laws of the
13 state relative to town taxes, but the city council may establish
14 further or additional provisions for the collection thereof.'

Sect. 2. Paragraph 6 of section 30 of same chapter be so
2 amended that one overseer shall exercise the powers of over-
3 seers of the poor instead of three as now provided.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
