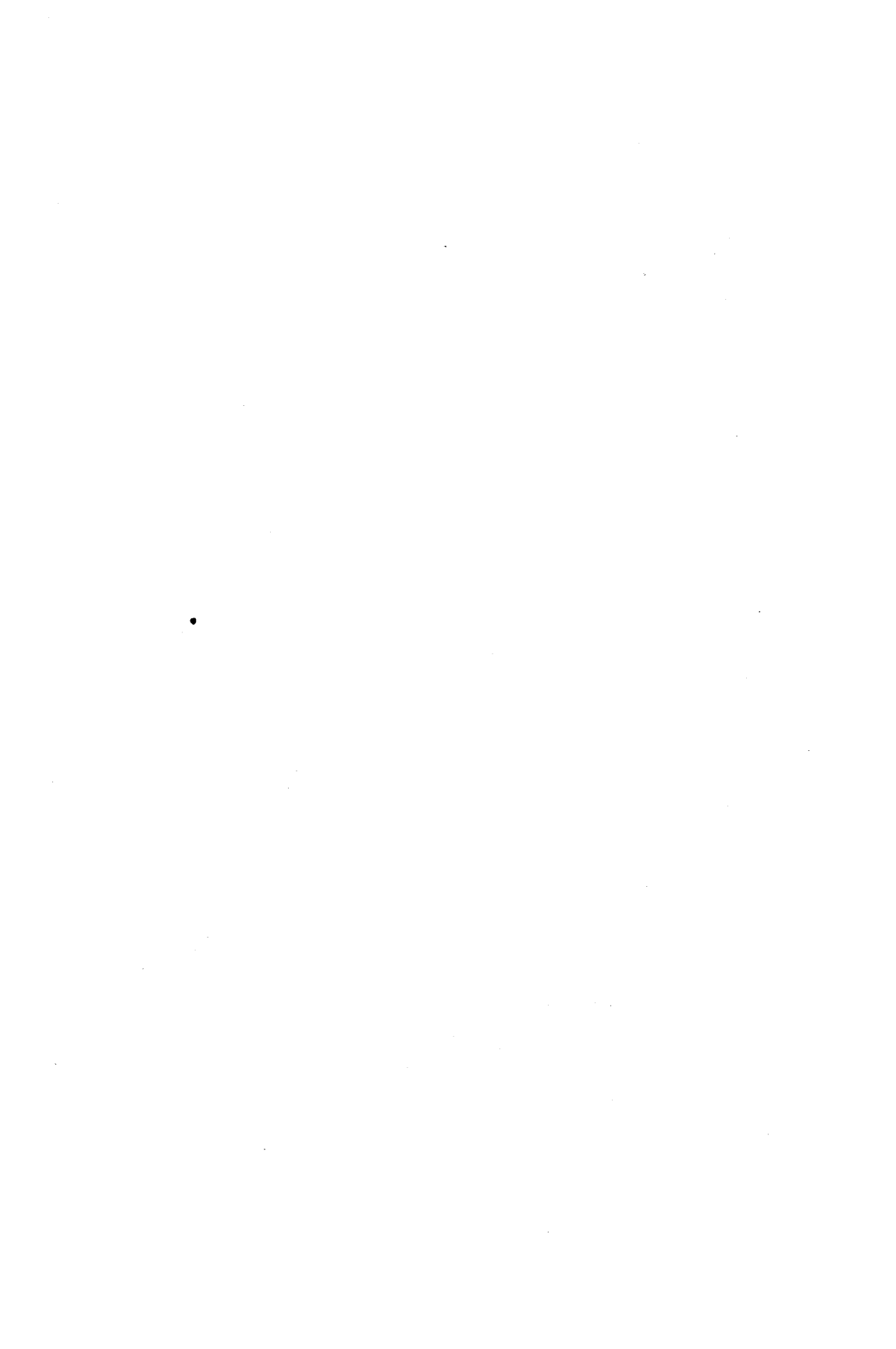
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT

Section 1. The Manufacturers Trust Company is hereby
