STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to extend the rights, powers and privileges of the Eastport Street Railway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Eastport

- 2 Street Railway which were granted by chapter four hundred
- 3 and sixty-five of the laws of the year one thousand eight hun-
- 4 dred and ninety-seven, are hereby extended for and during the
- 5 period of two years from the seventeenth day of March in the
- 6 year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, and all the
- 7 rights, powers and privileges, that were granted by said act
- 8 may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the
- 9 same purpose as provided in said act.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the seventeenth day of
- 2 March one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine.
