IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to extend the time for construction of the Boothbay Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The time within which the Boothbay Railroad
- 2 Company may commence construction is hereby extended to
- 3 March first, in the year nineteen hundred and one, and the acts
- 4 of the corporation in organization and location are hereby ratified
- 5 and approved.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
