IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

---

AN ACT relating to Chapter three hundred and sixty-six of  
the Private and Special Laws of 1897, entitled "An Act to in-  
corporate the Livermore Falls Water Company."

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges granted by  
2 chapter three hundred and sixty-six of the Private and Spec-  
3 ial Laws of 1897, entitled An Act to incorporate the Liver-  
4 more Falls Water Company, as amended by chapter five hun-  
5 dred and fifty-two of the Private and Special Laws of 1897.  
6 are hereby extended for and during the term of two years

7 from February twenty-fourth, 1899, and the time within  
8 which said corporation may commence actual business under  
9 its charter is hereby extended for the term of two years from  
10 February twenty-fourth, 1899.

Sect. 2. The organization of said the Livermore Falls  
2 Water Company is hereby confirmed, ratified and made valid.

Sect. 3. The said the Livermore Falls Water Company is  
2 hereby authorized and empowered to acquire, hold and dis-  
3 pose of shares of the capital stock and mortgage bonds of  
4 other similar corporations located and doing business in Liv-  
5 ermore, East Livermore and Jay, provided the same are ac-  
6 quired in the usual course of business of said corporation.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
