STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter eighty of the Revised
Statutes, relating to Sheriffs and their Deputies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section two of chapter eighty of the Revised Statutes is
2 hereby amended by striking out in the first line the words
3 “within such term” so that said section as amended shall read
4 as follows:

‘Sect. 2. Every sheriff, having executed such bond, shall file
6 it in the office of the clerk of the county commissioners of his
7 county, to be presented to them at their next meeting for
8 approval, and after the bond has been so approved, the clerk
9 shall record it and certify the fact thereon, and retaining a copy

10 thereof, deliver the original to the sheriff, who shall deliver it
11 to the treasurer of state, within twenty days after its approval,
12 to be filed in his office.
