STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE apportioning the appropriation for the Deaf, Dumb and
Blind for the year 1899.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-four thousand dollars appro-
2 priated by the resolve approved February, 1899, for the deaf,
3 dumb and blind for the year 1899, be apportioned as follows :
4 Fifteen thousand dollars to the Maine school for the deaf and
5 nine thousand dollars for the education of the blind, said sums
6 to be drawn from the treasury under the supervision of the gov-
7 ernor and council.
