STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated from the 2 funds in the state treasury the sum of ten thousand five hun-3 dred dollars for the use of the Maine Industrial School for Girls 4 at Hallowell to meet the current expenses for the year eighteen 5 hundred and ninety-nine, and ten thousand five hundred dollars 6 to meet the current expenses for the year nineteen hundred; 7 and seven hundred and fifty dollars for the purpose of providing 8 suitable fire escapes for the two halls now unprovided therewith. 9 This appropriation is made on the express condition that the 10 trustees of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell 11 convey to the state of Maine all the property, rights, privileges 12 and interests held and controlled by the said corporation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The annual appropriation asked for is the same in amount with that for the year 1898.

The new two-story building is fully furnished with means of escape from fire, the other two, three-storied, are not. The trustees believe the danger to the children from a fire to be serious, and ask for an appropriation of seven hundred and fifty dollars for the purpose of providing fire escapes. The institution has no funds which can be used for this purpose, and is in debt in a small amount for the new building.
