IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to provide for insurance on the Gorham Normal School building, Farmington Normal School buildings, Castine Normal School building, and Madawaska Training School buildings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The trustees of the state normal schools are hereby authorized 2 and empowered to insure for a sum not to exceed one hundred

- 3 thousand dollars the Gorham Normal School buildings, Farming-
- 4 ton Normal School building, Castine Normal School building, and
- 5 Madawaska Training School buildings for a term of three years.
