AN ACT to extend the charter of the Lewiston, Augusta and Camden Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The time within which the Lewiston, Augusta and Camden

- 8 dred any ninety-five, may file its locations and commence oper-
- 9 ations for building its lines, is hereby extended to December
- 10 thirty-one, nineteen hundred and one.
