STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred nineteen of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-one entitled "An Act to Prohibit the taking of Spawn Herring within a certain limit in Milbridge or Narraguagus Bay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred nineteen of the Private
2 and Special Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-one is hereby
3 amended by striking out all the words after the word "bay"
4 in fifth line to the words "under a penalty" and inserting
5 the following: 'and other waters above a line drawn from
6 Petit Manan lighthouse to Cape Split in the town of Addison'
7 so said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The taking of herring or fishing therefor by
9 the use of purse and drag seines or nets from the first
10 day of July to the first day of November, is hereby prohibited
11 in the waters lying within the jurisdiction of the State in
12 Milbridge or Narraguagus bay and other waters above a
13 line drawn from Petit Manan lighthouse to Cape Split in the
14 town of Addison, under a penalty upon the master or person
15 in charge of said seines or nets, or upon the owner or owners
16 of the vessels, steamers or boats engaged in taking said
17 herring, of not less than one hundred dollars, and no more
18 than three hundred dollars, and there shall be a lien upon
19 said vessels, steamers, boats and apparatus used in such
20 unlawful pursuit until said penalty, with costs of prosecution
21 is paid.'
