STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to prevent the taking of smelts by drag-seines in the waters of the Buck's Harbor, Orcutt's Harbor and Lawrence Bay, in the town of Brookville.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from taking any 2 smelts by drag-seines in the waters of Buck's Harbor, Orcutt's
- 3 Harbor and Lawrence Bay, in the town of Brookville.
- Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate the provisions of this act
- 2 shall, on conviction of the same, be punished by a fine of not
- 3 more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the county
- 4 jail for a term of not more than sixty days, and addition to the
- 5 said punishment, all boats, seines, and all other articles used in
- 6 the taking of said fish, and the fish so taken shall be forfeited

- 7 and disposed of, as provided in section forty-seven of chapter
- 8 two hundred and eighty-five of the Public Laws of eighteen hun-
- 9 dred and ninety-seven.
- Sect. 3. This act shall take effect April first, eighteen hun-2 dred and ninety-nine.
