## STATE OF MAINE.

In House of Representatives, March 7, 1899.

Ordered, That with a view to the equalization of taxation 2 in this State, and ascertaining the just proportional part of 3 the public burdens which should be borne by the various 4 classes of property, rights, and franchises held and exercised 5 in the State which may not be the subject of State, county 6 and municipal taxation according to their respective fair 7 values, the committee upon taxation be and hereby is author-8 ized and directed to inquire into the expediency of amending 9 the statutes so that a tax shall be assessed upon property 10 situated in unincorporated places at a rate equal to the aver-11 age of state, county and municipal taxation; of changing the 12 method of taxation of steam and street railroads so that the 13 franchise tax paid by such railroads in addition to the State, 14 county and municipal taxation on property owned by them 15 shall at all times be equal to their just and proportional part

16 of the revenue to be raised; of taxing such portion of the 17 capital of corporations organized and doing business in this 18 State, as is not invested in property which is subject to and 19 pays municipal taxes in some of the cities or towns of this 20 State; of providing for an annual franchise tax upon the 21 capital stock of corporations organized under the laws of 22 this State, but doing business elsewhere; of changing the 23 statutes in relation to the taxation of the stock and deposits 24 of trust companies organized under the laws of this State; 25 of changing the method of taxation of telegraph, telephone 26 and express companies, and of assessing a tax upon all sleep-27 ing and parlor car companies and car trusts doing business 28 in this State so that a just proportion of the State revenue 29 may be collected from these sources; of amending the stat-30 utes so as to require the filing with the assessors of every 31 town and city an inventory under oath, of all taxable property 32 of the several inhabitants thereof, and of inquiring into the 33 amount of taxes paid by foreign and domestic life and fire 34 insurance companies and by savings banks and all other cor-35 porations not hereinbefore enumerated and whether the same 36 is fair and reasonable; and said committee is authorized and 37 directed after the inquiry herein provided for to report to 38 the legislature on the whole subject matter of this order by 39 bill, or otherwise.
