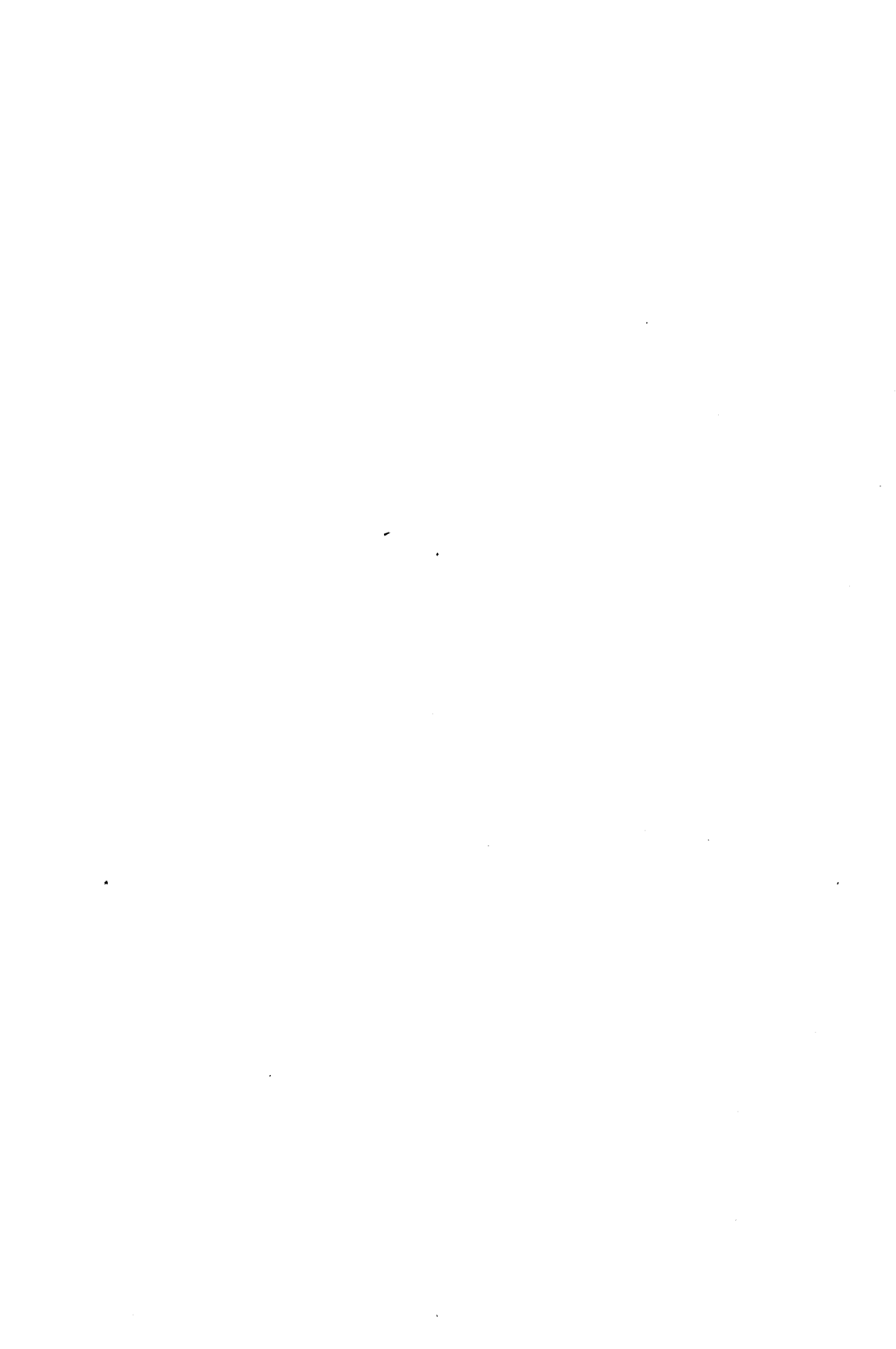
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to extend the Charter of the Maine Live Stock
Insurance Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Maine
2 Live Stock Insurance Company which were granted by
3 chapter two hundred and ninety-six, of the Private and Spec-
4 ial Laws for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and
5 extended two years by chapter three hundred and twenty-
6 nine, of the Private and Special Laws for the year eighteen
7 hundred and ninety-seven, are hereby extended for two years
8 additional; and the persons named in said act shall have all
9 the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by
10 said act, to be exercised in the same manner, and for the same
11 purposes, as provided in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
