STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Maine State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of fifteen thousand dollars 2 (\$15,000) be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf 3 of the Maine State Prison, to be expended under the direc-4 tion and supervision of the governor and council. \$5,000 5 for the payment of notes and bills outstanding and due. 6 \$5,000 for current expenses and \$5,000 for current expenses 7 for the year 1900.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The inspectors of the Maine State Prison, found at the close of the fiscal year, a note indebtedness of \$3,995 and other liabilities current of \$10,920.60, all of which should be paid promptly. The extreme depression in business for the past two years having prevented the prompt and profitable sale of the manufactured goods, it becomes necessary to meet this indebtedness by appropriations.

Therefore, it is recommended that the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) be appropriated for and in behalf of the Maine State Prison, to be expended under the direction and supervision of the governor and council. Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the payment of notes and bills outstanding and due; five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for current expenses and five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the year 1900.
