STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred twenty-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred forty-nine as amended by chapter five hundred two of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred fifty-two relating to the Free Bridge across Salt Pond in Bluehill.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter two hundred twenty-
2 six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred
3 forty-nine, as amended by chapter five hundred two of the
4 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred fifty-two, is
5 hereby amended by striking out all of said section after the
6 word "pass" in the third line thereof, so that said section, as
7 amended, shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 2. Said bridge shall be constructed of good materials, the abutments and pier to be of stone or wood, six feet
10 above common tides in that part where gondolas may pass.’

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
