STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to Re-equipping the National Guard.

Resolved, That on receipt of the money due to the State of
2 Maine from the United States government for expenses
3 incurred in organizing, arming and equipping the organiza-
4 tions of the United States volunteers, furnished by this State
5 under the two calls of the President during the war with
6 Spain, so much as may be necessary, of such part of said
7 money as is paid for the property actually pertaining to the
8 military department of the State at the beginning of the said
9 war, may be used under the direction of the governor and
10 council for uniforming, arming and equipping the national
11 guard of the State, from which it was taken.
