STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Joshua Gray of Gardiner and Wm. B.
Snow of Skowhegan.

Resolved, That the sum of seventy-eight dollars and thirty-
2 one cents be paid to Joshua Gray and Wm. B. Snow from the
3 State treasury to reimburse them for taxes paid twice on pub-
4 lic lots from the year 1887 to 1898, inclusive.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This is a case where Joshua Gray of Gardiner and Wm. B. Snow of Skowhegan paid taxes twice, and as the State assessors have no authority to give an abatement farther back than 1893, we ask the legislature to grant this abatement.
