STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT establishing a close time on Lobsters in Pigeon Hill Bay in the Towns of Milbridge and Steuben.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall take, catch, kill or destroy any

- 2 lobsters between the first day of July and the first day of Sep-
- 3 tember in each year, under a penalty of one dollar for each
- 4 lobster so taken, caught, killed or destroyed, in the waters of
- 5 Pigeon Hill bay, so called, in the towns of Milbridge and
- 6 Steuben, within the following points, namely: commencing
- 7 at Woods Pond Point on the west side of Pigeon Hill bay,
- 8 thence easterly to the Nubble on Little Bois Bubert island,
- 9 thence by the shore to the head of Bois Bubert island, thence

10 northerly to Joe Dyer's point, so called, thence by the shore 11 around Long Cove and the Creek, thence to the head of Pig12 eon Hill bay aforesaid, thence by the shore to the first men13 tioned bound.

Sect. 2. All fines and penalties under this act may be recov-2 ered as provided in section forty-eight of chapter two hundred 3 and eighty-five of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and 4 ninety-seven.
