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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

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AN ACT relating to sums paid by officers and collectors for  
Internal Revenue Stamps affixed to Deeds of Real Estate  
sold by them.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All sums paid by any officer for internal revenue  
2 stamps to be affixed to any deed of real estate, or interest  
3 therein, sold by him on execution, may be taxed by such offi-  
4 cer in his return on the execution, same as other fees and  
5 costs are taxed.

Sect. 2. All sums paid by any collector of taxes, or treas-  
2 urer, for internal revenue stamps to be affixed to any deed of  
3 real estate, or interest therein, sold for non-payment of a tax,  
4 shall be deemed a part of the costs and charges for making  
5 such sale.
