STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUK LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGH1 HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to sums paid by officers and collectors for Internal Revenue Stamps affixed to Deeds of Real Estate sold by them.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All sums paid by any officer for internal revenue 2 stamps to be affixed to any deed of real estate, or interest 3 therein, sold by him on execution, may be taxed by such offi-4 cer in his return on the execution, same as other fees and 5 costs are taxed.

Sect. 2. All sums paid by any collector of taxes, or treas-2 urer, for internal revenue stamps to be affixed to any deed of 3 real estate, or interest therein, sold for non-payment of a tax, 4 shall be deemed a part of the costs and charges for making 5 such sale.
