STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the Cape Porpoise Land Company to erect and maintain a Toll Bridge at Cape Porpoise.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Cape Porpoise Land Company, a corporation 2 organized and existing under the general laws of the State 3 of Maine, is hereby authorized and empowered to erect, con-4 struct and maintain a toll bridge for foot and carriage travel, 5 or a tramway for passenger and freight traffic across tide 6 waters between said main-land at Cape Porpoise and Trotts 7 island, and between said main-land and Stage island in the 8 town of Kennebunkport, in the county of York.

Sect. 2. A toll for the use and benefit of the Cape Porpoise 2 Land Company is hereby granted and established, and a 3 tariff of tolls shall be fixed and agreed upon by the Cape Por-4 poise Land Company and the selectmen of the town of Ken-5 nebunkport; and in case the said company and the selectmen 6 shall disagree as to the toll rates to be charged, they shall 7 refer the rate of tolls to the county commissioners of the 8 county of York and their decision shall be final. --
