STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section two of Chapter 294 of the Public Laws of 1889, Fixing the Salary of the County Commissioners of Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of Chapter 294 of the Public Laws

- 2 of 1889, is hereby amended, by striking out the word "eighty"
- 3 in the second line thereof, and inserting in place thereof the
- 4 word 'ninety;' also by striking out in the fourth and fifth
- 5 lines, the words, "two dollars and twenty-five cents" and
- 6 inserting in place thereof the words 'two dollars and fifty
- 7 cents,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows:
- 'Sect. 2. From and after the first day of January, in the 9 year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-

10 nine, the salary of each of the county commissioners for the
11 county of Kennebec, shall be two dollars and fifty cents per
12 day, instead of the sum now fixed by law, while actually
13 employed in the service of the county, including the time spent
14 in travelling, for which he shall have ten cents a mile for the
15 distance actually traveled.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
