STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to legalize the doings of the First Universalist
Society of Westbrook.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All the acts and doings of the First Universalist
2 Society of Westbrook in its corporate capacity since the fifth
3 day of February, A. D. 1895, are hereby legalized and made
4 valid.

Sect. 2. All persons who are now renters of pews in the
2 church edifice of said society at Saccarappa in the city of
3 Westbrook, are hereby declared to be and are members of
4 said corporation, the First Universalist Society of Westbrook.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
