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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

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AN ACT additional to chapter eighty-one of the Revised  
Statutes relating to the sale on writ, of personal property  
attached.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Personal property attached may be kept upon the premises  
2 where the same is found and the attaching officer may  
3 appoint a keeper thereof; but if the owner of said property  
4 or the occupant of said premises requests the officer, in writ-  
5 ing, to remove said keeper, the officer shall remove the prop-  
6 erty attached or the keeper without reasonable delay. If  
7 the defendant, in writing, requests the officer making the  
8 attachment to allow said property attached to remain upon

9 the premises where found until he may give a bond dissolv-  
10 ing said attachment, the officer shall not remove said prop-  
11 erty, until the defendant has had a reasonable opportunity  
12 to give said bond.
